Additional Services and Enrichment Fees

Funding is given for children to access standard provision only. As a nursery, we must use it to adequately deliver the EYFS curriculum. This includes things such as small world figures, role play, puzzles, books, loose parts, construction, craft supplies and staffing to meet minimum government ratios.

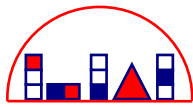
When accessing funded hours, we make a charge called additional service fee of £1.50 per funded hour, to cover everything that the funding doesn't provide. This includes all of the extra experiences we offer within our service throughout the year as well as nappies and food (2 snacks and a 2 course lunch) Consumable fees cover things such as planting, zoo lab visit, Zumba and sports instructors, parties, stay and plays, sensory room experience, additional staffing for walks in the local area, boogie mites and phonics programmes as well as much more. The additional service fee charge allows us to purchase additional resources and equipment to enable additional experiences such as hi viz jackets, waterproof clothing and sensory equipment. It also supports staff training and development beyond the mandatory qualifications, meaning practitioners have high standards of knowledge and skills to support children's development.

You can opt out

If you choose to opt out, please note that some sessions/days will need to be changed throughout the year, depending upon when our enhanced provision sessions are, we will give you a list of dates each half term that will need to be changed.

Parents choosing not to pay the additional service fee will incur the following charges on an ad hoc basis when 'opting in' on the additional extras.

If you decide to opt out and receive your basic government provision of 15 or 30 hours free of charge this will be available only on selected sessions. We will also supply you with a list of everything you will need to bring in for every session your child attends. We will need to check this before you leave and if there is anything not supplied then your child will be unable to attend due to lack of provision provided.

As detailed above we are unable to provide food free of charge, we cannot accept lunch boxes from home due to allergy risks and food storage limitations under food hygiene legislation. We are not able to ask parents to collect children during a session solely for the purpose of feeding them.

Please note other ad hoc extras may occur through the year – parents will be given the option in these cases for their child to participate and pay the fee.
